ITEM 1.01 ENTRY INTO A MATERIAL DEFINITIVE AGREEMENT

On January 18, 2007, the board of directors of Transax International Limited, a Colorado corporation (the Company), approved the execution of a letter of intent (the Letter of Intent) with Gestao e Processamento de Informacoes de Saude Ltda, (CBGS) the wholly-owned subsidiary of Companhia Brasileira de Meios de Pagamento, which is the leading credit card payment processor in Brazil. In accordance with the terms and provisions of the Letter of Intent, the Company is proposing to sell to CBGS 100% of the total issued and outstanding shares of its wholly-owned subsidiary, Medlink Conectividade em Saude Ltda (Medlink), and related intellectual property held by Medlink Technologies, Inc. for the consideration of approximately \$5,900,000.

In accordance with the further terms and provisions of the Letter of Intent, CBGS will pay cash and retain operating control of Medlink's assets and intellectual property rights in Brazil. The proposed transaction is subject to financial and legal due diligence and any closing balance sheet adjustments to be completed by approximately February 28, 2007.

In the event that the Company and CBGS enter into a final definitive agreement after the successful completion of due diligence, the Company will continue to retain licensing rights outside of Latin America and intellectual property rights for the United States market.
