**Item 4.01 Changes in Registrant's Certifying Accountant.**

Effective January 13, 2014, The Prudential Employee Savings Plan (the Plan) engaged SB & Company, LLC as its new independent registered public accounting firm. The decision to engage SB & Company, LLC was previously approved by the Administrative Committee of the Plan.
