Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Represents shares of restricted common stock granted to the reporting person pursuant to the issuer's long-term incentive compensation plan for employees. The shares vest ratably over a three-year period on each annual anniversary of the grant.
- Each performance right represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock at vesting. The performance rights vest at a rate between 0% and 200% based on the issuer's average return on net assets ("RONA") during a three-year performance cycle beginning on January 1, 2013 and ending on December 31, 2015 in comparison to the RONA averages of a predetermined peer group over the same performance cycle. The performance rights may be settled, at the issuer's discretion, in cash or shares of common stock.
- (2) Each performance right represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock at vesting. 90% of the performance rights vest at a rate of 0% to 200% based on the issuer's operating margin and sales growth during a three-year period beginning on January 1, 2013 and ending on December 31, 2015. 10% of the performance rights vest, if at all, at December 31, 2015 if the CEO determines that a COO succession candidate is ready within one year or three or more operating presidents are ready to report directly to the CEO.
