Michigan Gas Storage's transmission system consists of 521 miles of pipelines within M owns and operates two compressor stations with a total of 53,500 installed horsepower. Mic storage fields located in Osceola, Clare and Missaukee counties of Michigan with an aggreg bcf.

In November 2001, Michigan Gas storage filed an application with the Federal Ener declaration of exemption from provisions of the National Gas Act. Upon approval of the Michigan Gas Storage and its facilities would be merged into Consumers Energy Company.
