**Oncolytics Biotech Inc. Announces Conclusion of Patient Follow Up in  
Canadian Phase I Recurrent Malignant Glioma Clinical Trial**

**CALGARY, AB, January 17, 2006** Oncolytics Biotech Inc. ( Oncolytics ) (TSX:ONC, NASDAQ:ONCY) announced today that the six-month follow up period has been concluded for patients in its Phase I Canadian recurrent malignant glioma clinical trial. As reported in October 2005, intratumoural administration of reovirus was well tolerated by the patients and a maximum tolerated dose was not reached. Surviving patients continue to be monitored and data analysis is ongoing.

We intend to continue to investigate REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup> as a monotherapy in our U.S. Phase I/II malignant glioma clinical trial, employing an alternative delivery method, said Dr. Brad Thompson, President and CEO of Oncolytics. We are also considering the potential use of REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup> in combination with both the chemotherapeutics and radiation therapy that are the current standards of care for malignant glioma.

The study examined the use of a single, intratumoural injection of REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup>, delivered using imaging-guided surgery, in patients with malignant gliomas that had recurred despite other treatments, including surgery and radiation therapy. A total of 12 patients were treated in the study at dosages of 10<sup>7</sup>, 10<sup>8</sup>, and 10<sup>9</sup> TCID<sub>50</sub> in a delivery volume of 0.9 ml.

**About Oncolytics Biotech Inc.**

Oncolytics is a Calgary-based biotechnology company focused on the development of REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup>, its proprietary formulation of the human reovirus, as a potential cancer therapeutic. Oncolytics researchers have demonstrated that the reovirus is able to selectively kill cancer cells and, *in vitro*, kill human cancer cells that are derived from many types of cancer including breast, bladder, prostate, pancreatic and brain tumours, and have also demonstrated successful cancer treatment results in a number of animal models. Previous Phase I clinical trial results have indicated that REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup> was well tolerated and that the reovirus demonstrated activity in tumours injected with REOLYSIN<sup>®</sup>.
