(1) The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$115.8496 to \$117.05, inclusive. (2) Prior to March 1, 2013, this option may become exercisable in 1/3 increments if the daily closing price of Kansas City Southern's common stock on the New York Stock Exchange is greater than or equal to \$38.95, \$42.85, and \$47.14, respectively, for at least 30 consecutive trading days. The first target was met and 16,400 of these options became exercisable on November 19, 2010. The second target was met and 16,400 of these options became exercisable on December 8, 2010. The third target was met and 16,400 of these options became exercisable on January 7, 2011.

(3) These options become exercisable in three equal installments beginning on the first anniversary of the date of grant.
